

It is common for construction contract to set out liquidated damages. Does that mean that the amount stated is the maximum available limit? 13:50pm • **SESSION 3:** The Conundrum in Choosing the Seat and Venue of Arbitration For Construction Projects in the Borneo Region

In Masenang Sdn Bhd v Sabanilam Enterprise Sdn Bhd [2021] 6 MLJ 255, the Federal Court held that: "Issue 3: Whether, in the context of there being two separate territorial jurisdictions in Malaysia, the seat of a domestic arbitration may be a state or a territory within Malaysia. [185] Yes, the seat of a domestic arbitration will be a place within Malaysia. The seat of a domestic arbitration cannot simply be said to be Malaysia. The seat is usually specified to be, for example, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, or Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia, or Penang, Malaysia, as the parties see fit to choose in their arbitration agreement or as determined by the arbitral tribunal pursuant to s 22 of the AA." In this session, panellists will discuss the implications of the Masenang case and highlight the crucial considerations for parties to select the seat and venue of arbitration for construction projects in the Borneo region.


