

AN INTRODUCTION TO THE FIDIC CONTRACTS AND CLAIMS

The FIDIC forms of contract have become the go-to and most frequently used construction contracts internationally, particularly in countries that have not developed their own standard contracts. FIDIC contracts are available for construction; design and build; engineer, procure and construct; design, build and operate; small works; tunnelling, dredging and consultancy services, so it is vital to select the most appropriate form of contract for the project.

In the first part of the presentation, Andy will introduce the FIDIC forms of contract and explain their various uses within the industry. He will also offer advice on how to select the right contract for your project to ensure success.

In the second part of the presentation, Paul will discuss claims and offer some tips on how to compile a strong claim. Badly presented construction claims do not allow the parties to settle issues amicably, which often leads to expensive dispute resolution. By getting your claim developed properly, you will ensure that you are in a better position to negotiate.
